Possession of a valid certificate from the First Aid GWO Basic Safety Training, as well as the Working at Heights GWO Training is required. Participants must be physically able to work in the selected work environment.

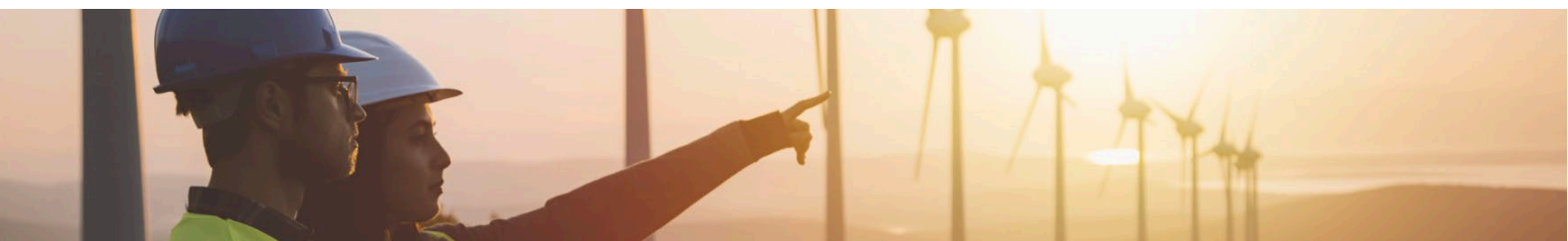
