- The delegate will be aware of requirements for site as detailed in British and European standards and best practice guides
- The delegate will be aware of the residual risks which cannot be eliminated by design and their requirement for safety measures
- The delegate will be aware of 'out-of-service' criteria and importance to manage against unauthorized use
- The delegate will be able to complete records and management, relating to pre-use checks and 'concern' reporting
- The delegate will be able to describe all the functions of the main parts of a BMU
- The delegate will be able to use the manuals as reference for finding information
